



Who can join AUDE?

The Association of University Directors of Estates (AUDE) is an institutional membership Association.

All UK higher education institutions granted degree awarding powers by Royal Charter or Act of Parliament and designated as 'recognised bodies' are eligible to join.

Associate Membership may be granted, at the discretion of the AUDE Executive committee, to other institutions funded by any of the UK Higher Education Funding Councils (England, Scotland and Wales) and institutions funded by the Department for Employment and Learning (Northern Ireland).

Associate membership may be granted, at the discretion of the Executive, to other publicly funded UK bodies with a purpose and remit which includes a significant element of higher education teaching and/or research.

Membership is subject to the payment of a membership subscription.

Subscription rates are determined by the AUDE members. At present (2008) rates are on a sliding scale based on the income of the institution (HESA figures). Subscriptions are normally paid annually.

Each AUDE member institution appoints a representative. Normally this will be the Director of Estates or equivalent.
